WHEREAS, as a result of these events, the district has to create flexibility and options for education in response to the pandemic, in order to continue providing instruction to students; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the Wilmington City School District, County of Clinton, State of Ohio, that:

The Board supports that students will be required to wear face coverings while riding the school bus and that it will be highly recommended to wear face coverings when 6 feet of social distancing is not practical. If Clinton County is at an Alert Level 3 and/or the Governor

has issued a state mandated order, the Board supports that students will be required to wear face coverings in all school settings. The Board supports that the district will continue to assess the requirements and wearing of face coverings as directed by the State and Local Health Departments and the Governor.
