<u>308-021 APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION TO LIFT MASK MANDATE AND IMPLEMENT</u> <u>NEW QUARANTINE PROTOCOL OPTION</u>

Motion by Zeigler, seconded by Snarr to approve the following resolution to lift the mask mandate and implement the new quarantine protocol option that was released by ODE "Mask to Stay, Test to Play".

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2020, the head of the World Health Organization declared COVID-19 a pandemic; and

WHEREAS, vaccinations are available for students and staff ages 12 and up and staff have the option to receive a booster shot; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Health issued a new Mask to Stay/Test to Play Quarantine Option on Monday, October 25, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the infection rates and active COVID-19 cases are declining; and

WHEREAS, the active COVID-19 cases for students over approximately 3 weeks significantly declined to an average of 3 cases per week and in within various buildings; and

WHEREAS, our student attendance rate is steadily increasing to our normal daily average; and

WHEREAS, there has been only one active COVID-19 case within our staff since October 11, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Clinton County Health Commissioner and Medical Director support lifting the mask mandate;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the Wilmington City School District, County of Clinton, State of Ohio, that:

The Board supports the Ohio Department of Health Mask to Stay/Test to Play Quarantine option.

The Board supports lifting the district wide mask mandate effective October 29, 2021. The Board supports the discretion of the Superintendent in consultation with the Clinton County Health Commissioner and Medical Director to determine a 14 day mask requirement for any localized outbreaks of COVID-19 in classroom and/or building and/or district settings.
