<u>033-23 APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION TO PROCEED / SCHOOL DISTRICT INCOME</u> TAX

RESOLUTION PROPOSING THE LEVY OF AN ANNUAL TAX
FOR SCHOOL DISTRICT PURPOSES ON THE SCHOOL
DISTRICT INCOME OF INDIVIDUALS AND OF ESTATES AND
DETERMINING TO PROCEED WITH SUBMISSION OF SAID LEVY

WHEREAS, this board of education at its meeting on the 19th day of December, 2022, by resolution duly adopted, determined the necessity of raising

\$5,400,000 per year for school district purposes, and further provided that application be made to the Tax Commissioner of the Ohio Department of Taxation to estimate the property tax rate that would have to be imposed by the Wilmington City School District (the "School District") in the current year to produce said additional annual amount and to estimate the income tax rate that would have had to have been in effect for the current year as a school district income tax to produce said additional annual amount; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Commissioner of the Ohio Department of Taxation has certified to this board of education that the estimated property tax rate that would have to be imposed by the School District in the current year to produce said additional annual amount is 9.53 mills and that the estimated income tax rate that would have had to have been in effect for the current year as a school district income tax to produce said additional annual amount is 0.75%;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Wilmington City School District:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to Section 5748.02 of the Ohio Revised Code, as amended (the "Act"), a levy of an annual tax for the purpose of current expenses and general on-going permanent improvements on the school district income of individuals and estates as defined in divisions (E)(1)(a) and (2) of Section 5748.01 of the Ohio Revised Code is hereby proposed and it is hereby determined to proceed with the submission to the electors of the school district the question of levying for five years an income tax of seventy-five hundredths percent (.75%) per annum on the school district income of individuals and of estates for the purpose of current expenses and general on-going permanent improvements at the election to be held on May 2, 2023. Said tax, if approved by the electors, shall be effective January 1, 2024. Of the proceeds of the levy, ninety-five percent (95%) thereof will be utilized for current expenses and the remaining five percent (5%) shall be earmarked for general on-going permanent improvements.

SECTION 2. That the treasurer of this board of education be and is hereby directed to immediately certify the following to the board of elections: (a) this resolution and (b) the estimated property tax rate that would have to be imposed in the current year to produce said additional annual amount and the estimated income tax rate that would have had to have been in effect for the current year as a school district income tax to produce said additional annual amount, as calculated and certified by the Tax Commissioner of the Ohio Department of Taxation, and to notify said board of elections to cause notice of such election to be given as required by law.

SECTION 3. That the form of ballot, upon which the question of levying said tax shall be submitted to the electors, shall be substantially as follows, provided that this form of the ballot language may be altered to comply with any requirements of this applicable Board of Elections and/or the Ohio Secretary of State:

PROPOSED TAX LEVY

WILMINGTON CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

Shall an annual income tax of seventy-five hundredths percent (.75%) on the school district income of individuals and of estates be imposed by the Wilmington City School District for five years, beginning January 1, 2024, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CURRENT EXPENSES AND GENERAL ON-GOING PERMANENT IMPROVEMENTS?

FOR THE TAX LEVY
AGAINST THE TAX LEVY

SECTION 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this board of education concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this board of education; and that all deliberations of this board of education and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section I2I.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
