

Advertisement for Bids

Sealed bids will be received in accordance with the law until 11:30 o'clock a.m. on April 11, 2023, at the offices of the Board of Education of Wilmington City School District ("Board"), located at 341 South Nelson Avenue, Wilmington, Ohio, for REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR FOOD SERVICE OPERATIONS AND MANAGEMENT SERVICES (the "Project"). The bids will be publicly opened and read by the Treasurer at 11:30 o'clock a.m. on April 11, 2023. The bids shall be tabulated and reported by the Treasurer to the Board at its next meeting.

No bid shall be considered unless made on the forms available at the office of the Treasurer of the Board, and in accordance with the contract documents, which consist of all advertisements and notices, the instructions to bidders, specifications and drawings, bid form, form of contract agreement, forms of performance bond and bid and performance bond, schedule of wage rates, and addenda thereto, all of which are available and may be obtained upon request at that office. A mandatory meeting with interested bidders to review the specifications, to clarify any questions, and for a walk-through of the facilities with school officials will be on March 24, 2023 at 1:30 pm at 341 South Nelson Avenue, Wilmington, OH 45177. Location: District Board Office. Attendance is required. Submit questions regarding the RFP in writing by 12 Noon EST on March 20, 2023 to Curt Bone via curt.bone@wilmington.k12.oh.us.

Bids must contain the name of every person interested therein and be accompanied by: (1) a certified check, cashier's check, or letter of credit in an amount equal to ten percent of the bid tendered as a guarantee that the bidder will, if the award is made to the bidder, enter into a proper contract with the Board for the Project and furnish a performance bond for the amount of the contract at the time the bidder executes the contract. All such bonds, certified checks, cashier's checks, and letters of credit shall be payable to the Board of Education of the Wilmington City School District.

The Board intends to accept the lowest responsible bid for the Project, but reserves the right to reject any and all, or part of any and all, bids and to waive irregularities which may occur in the bidding.

No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty days after the scheduled closing time for receipt of the bids.

The attention of bidders is called to the statutory requirements of the State of Ohio relating to the licensing of corporations organized under the laws of any other state, and to the contract documents available at the office of the Treasurer.
