

Dance Guidelines

We expect students and guests to behave in a manner which shows respect for themselves and others. Students who violate dance guidelines will be removed from the dance and their parents will be contacted.

- All dances are WHS school functions and therefore governed by the student code of conduct. WHS
 dances are for WHS students and their pre-approved guests only.
- Students must check in as they arrive. Students must give their ticket to an adult ticket taker at the door.
- Students are not permitted to go to the parking lot or any area not designated for students at the dance. All students must be in the dance by the required time. The doors will shut and no one is permitted to enter after that time. Students are permitted to leave the dance at a specific time. We will not release students before that time.
- Dance behavior: Appropriate physical contact only. Sexually suggestive dancing will not be tolerated. If the behavior looks questionable, it will be stopped. Lewd dancing will not be tolerated. Students that choose to dance in this manner will be warned and then removed from the dance. Parents will be contacted if a student is not following dancing guidelines for removal arrangements.
- If a student is suspected to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs at a dance, or if they refuse to
 cooperate with any of the rules or expectations, we will contact the student's parent/guardian, and ask
 that they come pick up their student. Since school rules apply at all school events, students will face
 disciplinary action if they are found to be under the influence or in possession of alcohol or other drugs.
- Ticket price will not be refunded if a student is asked to leave the dance.

Students are **NOT** permitted to:

- "Mosh" or slam dance
- Vulgar, seductive, or inappropriate movements
- Get on shoulders of another student
- Lie or sit on the floor
- Bring in any type of beverage from outside of the dance
- Run through or around the dance area
- Act in a manner that is unsafe for themselves or others
