Campus Parking Notes

1. Hurricane Alley: This is the designated area for all parents/guardians to drop off students in the morning and to pick up students in the afternoon for the middle school and high school.
2. Middle School Staff Parking only.
3. High School Student Parking only with assigned parking spaces.
4. High School Staff Parking and used for parents to pick up and drop off students while the school day is in progress.
5. High School Staff Parking only.
6. Bus Horseshoe is used by busses to drop off and pick up students. Parents/Guardians may use this route to pick up and drop off students in the middle school when there are no busses in the horseshoe.
